

## PRIVACY POLICY

This is the privacy policy of the International Association for Police Officers, based in Alkmaar and registered in the trade register of the Chamber of Commerce under number 70563047 (“IAPO”). This privacy policy describes what personal information is registered on the website <https://www.iapo.info> and is processed when you visit us.

In this privacy policy, the website <https://www.iapo.info> is referred to as: <https://www.iapo.info>.

### 1. USE OF PERSONAL DATA

- 1.1 When you visit the website, <https://www.iapo.info> may ask personal data of you if you:
  - (a) become a member of the International Association for Police officers
- 1.2 In addition, the IAPO collects and uses personal data about visitors of the website through:
  - (b) IP registrations.
- 1.3 IAPO collects the following (personal) data:
  - (c) name;
  - (d) address;
  - (e) e-mail address;
  - (f) telephone number;
  - (g) age;
  - (h) gender;
  - (i) IBAN bank account number and/or swiftcode
  - (j) Personal interests
- 1.4 The IAPO uses this data (possible) to:
  - (k) to effect and create the membership;
  - (l) to send newsletters;
  - (m) contact you or to maintain the membership

### 2. USE OF COOKIES AND VISITOR REGISTRATION

- 2.1 On <https://www.iapo.info> the IAPO uses your IP registration. For more information about the use of IP registration by IAPO and to set up your permissions for the application thereof, please refer to the cookie manager ([contact@iapo.info](mailto:contact@iapo.info))
- 2.2 Where, as a result of the registration of IP addresses, information is posted or read out and this is not strictly necessary for the performance of the communication with you or for a specific service requested by you, you will be informed in advance and be asked for permission. See the cookie manager. It is possible that some parts of the website without cookies etc. will not function properly.

### **3. INFORMATION, MODIFICATION AND OBJECTION**

### **4. PROTECTION OF YOUR DATA**

4.1 IAPO uses your specific details only for the use of the IAPO registration mentioned purposes which are specified in this privacy policy. They will no longer be kept than necessary.

4.2 IAPO has implemented the following security measures:

- (r) encrypted filing
- (s) security on internet connections
- (t) connection check
- (u) Data of details are stored on a specific Datasure USB stick which needs a specific code. Then an extra code is necessary to obtain details. The Datasure USB stick is removed from the computer when not in use.
- (v) IAPO will take appropriate technical and organizational measures to secure your data.

### **5. THIRD PARTIES**

5.1 The IAPO will not provide your information to third parties unless you have given your expressed permission or is required to do so on the basis of the IAPO by law or court order.

### **6. PERSONAL DATA AUTHORITY NOTIFICATION**

6.1 When, despite the security measures taken by us in the unlikely event that an infringement is or has taking place, and this leads (or possibly may lead to) considerably serious adverse consequences for the protection of your personal data, the Personal data Authority will be informed and notified.

### **7. NOTIFICATION TO INDIVIDUAL MEMBER**

7.1 In the event of any breach of our security, you will be notified, if the breach is likely to affect your personal privacy.

### **8. AMENDMENTS TO PRIVACY POLICY**
